

Informative notice in compliance with art. 13, Legislative Decree 196/03

According to Art. 13 of the Legislative Decree June 20th, 2003, nr.196 Code concerning the protection of personal data (hereinafter referred to as Code), **GIMAT SRL Unipersonal**, with legal office in Via Giotto da Bondone nr. 10/14, in Fiorano Modenese (Mo), zip code 41042, Fiscal Code/VAT Payers Number nr. 02495780369, would like to inform you of the following:

1. Purposes and methods of data processing

The treatment that data required to you or acquired from you will undergo is exclusively directed to the management of the business relationship established and to the performance of all obligations prior to contracts or under contracts, deriving from administrative, accounting, organizational, administrative and fiscal obligations and under the Law.

The processing of personal data shall be carried out by means of operations or set of operations set forth by Art. 4, comma 1, Letter a) of the Code: *"any operation or set of operations performed on personal data, whether or not by electronic instruments, concerning the collection, recording, organization, storage, elaboration or alteration, selection, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, blocking, erasure or destruction of personal data regardless of their being filed in a data bank"*.

The personal data shall mean, by definition of the normative in force *"any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person, who can be identified, directly or indirectly by reference to information in kind, including personal identification number"* required to the person or acquired, that shall be processed, whether on hard copy or automatic means or information technology, by the recipient subjects in charge thereof.

We would like to inform you that the processing of data shall be performed according to the Minimum Security Mandatory Measures as of Arts. 31,33,34,35 and Attachment B) of said Code. Moreover, we would like to inform you that your personal data shall be treated in compliance with the rules set forth by Art. 11 Legislative Decree 196/03.

2. Compulsory or voluntary nature of data disclosure

According to the principal of individual autonomy of the data subject, the disclosure of personal data is subsidiary, and yet, it is strictly necessary for the correct management of the business relationship established and to the performance of all pre contractual, contractual, organizational, administrative, accounting, fiscal obligations deriving thereof and all obligations under the Law.

3. Consequences of a potential refusal to personal data disclosure

Any potential refusal to disclose personal data by the data subject, implies the failure to perform the above mentioned objectives and the inability to correctly manage the business relationship established and all pending obligations deriving thereof.

4. Recipient to whom personal data may be disclosed or who may come into knowledge of personal data

Personal data may be provided to the purposes mentioned in point 1 above and to be processed according to the same purposes or to those provided for by law to:

- the recipients appointed by the Data Controller, to the purpose of managing the business relationship established and to the performance of all pre contractual, contractual, organizational, administrative, accounting, fiscal obligations and all obligations deriving thereof and under the Law;
- the internal or external recipients, who may be appointed by the Data Controller, in charge of the processing and managing of the data or of the processing procedure thereof;
- companies or other professionals who perform a specific task on behalf of the Data Controller, for personal data (consulting and accountancy, administrative, fiscal and management assistance, information system management, etc...), to the performance of which the data disclosure is necessary;
- credit Banks, and when necessary, Financial enterprises, leasing, debt collection, credit protection and transfer, economic transaction management companies;
- companies and legal offices, when necessary, for the protection of any contractual rights;
- Government Bodies, central or peripheral ones, Public Bodies and other Institutions under the Law.

Personal data shall not be subject to disclosure.

5. Rights pursuant to art.7

Art. 7. Right of access to personal data and other rights

1. The interested data subject has the right to obtain confirmation on whether personal data regarding him/herself exists, even if not yet registered, and their communication in intelligible form.

2. The interested data subject has the right to obtain indication on:

- a) the source of personal data;
- b) the finalities and modalities of processing;
- c) the logic applied in case of processing carried out with the aid of electronic means;
- d) Identification Data of the Data Controller, of the people in charge and of the representative appointed according to art 5, comma 2;
- e) the subjects or set of subjects to whom the personal data may be disclosed or who may come into knowledge thereof as person designated by the State to the purpose or as person responsible or in charge thereof.

3. The interested data subject has the right to obtain:

- a) the update, the rectification that is, when interested, the integration of data;
- b) the deletion, transformation into anonymous form or block of the data being processed in case of law breach, included those whose conservation is not necessary in relation to the purposes for which the data have been collected and subsequently processed.
- c) the declaration that the operations stated in points a) and b) together with their content, have been brought to the knowledge of those, whose data have been communicated and disclosed, except for the case in which such obligation proves impossible or would take the use of means blatantly out of proportions in comparison with the right being protected.

4. The interested data subject has the right to oppose fully or in part:

- a) in case of legitimate reasons regarding own personal data, though pertaining the purpose of the data collection;
- b) to the processing of own personal data to the purpose of transmitting advertising material, of the direct sales or of market research or commercial advices.

6. The identification data of the Data Controller or other people in charge
